

Getting Start	ed
Overview	For a video overview of recording your first screencast-o- matic video capture, enter the following URL into your browser's address bar: http://www.screencast-o-matic.com/u/h/start-recording
Things you'll need	You'll need a mic/headset. If you don't have a headset and plan to use your onboard computer microphone, be sure that you are in a quiet place that has no background noise. Pay attention to the noise put off by fans, air conditioning, heaters, music or TV or peopledo a quick test to hear what you might be missing!
Begin Recording	Go to <u>http://www.screencast-o-matic.com</u> to begin. Click on Start Recording to record.


Screen recorder features:

- a) Select Screen, to record your screen within the dotted target area
- b) If you have a webcam, you can choose Both to record both within the video.
- c) Select a screensize of 480p or higher.
- d) Select your microphone. A headset is preferred, but the mic next to your webcam is good.
 (Ensure that you are in a quiet area. Do a test recording to see if the a/c or fans etc are too loud).
- e) Click on the red Rec button to begin recording


Screen Recorder 2.0:



Positioning the target area Click on the Settings icon to hide the menu, then click and drag the center target to reposition the target area. Your video will record whatever content is contained within the target area



Click on Done when finished recording.



Click on Upload to Screencast-O-Matic to register for a free account and upload the video.

If you have a YouTube account, you can also upload to YouTube and copy the video link from there.
