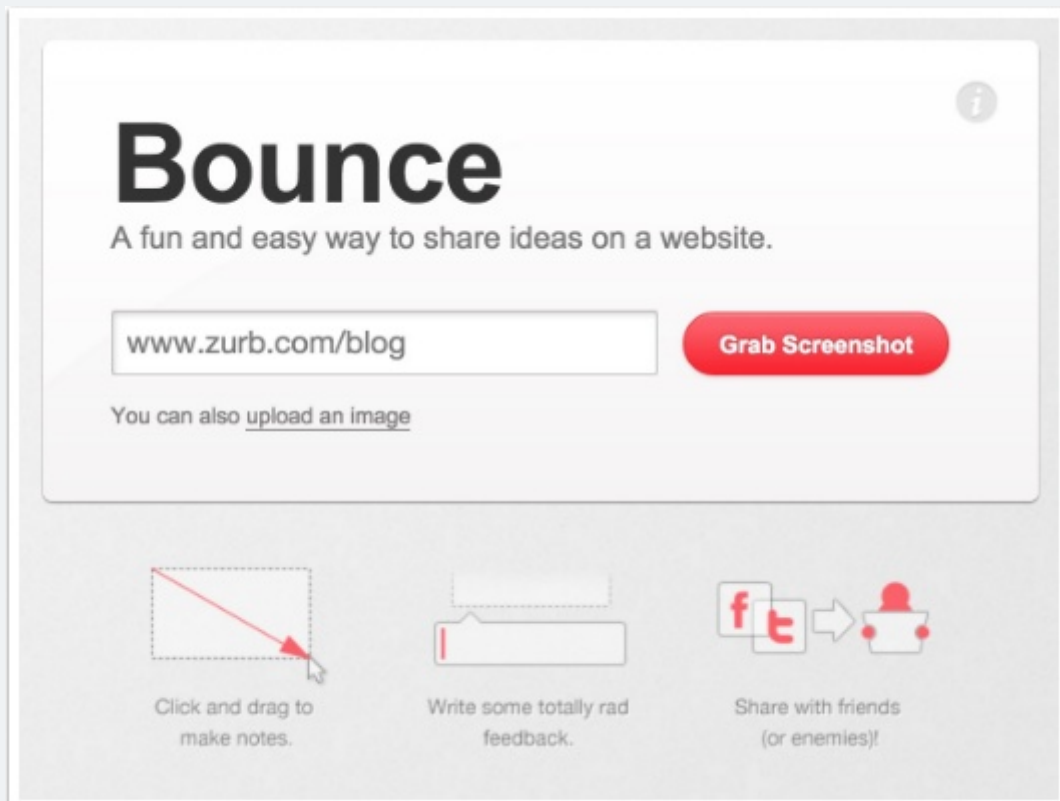

## 1. Visit the BounceApp website

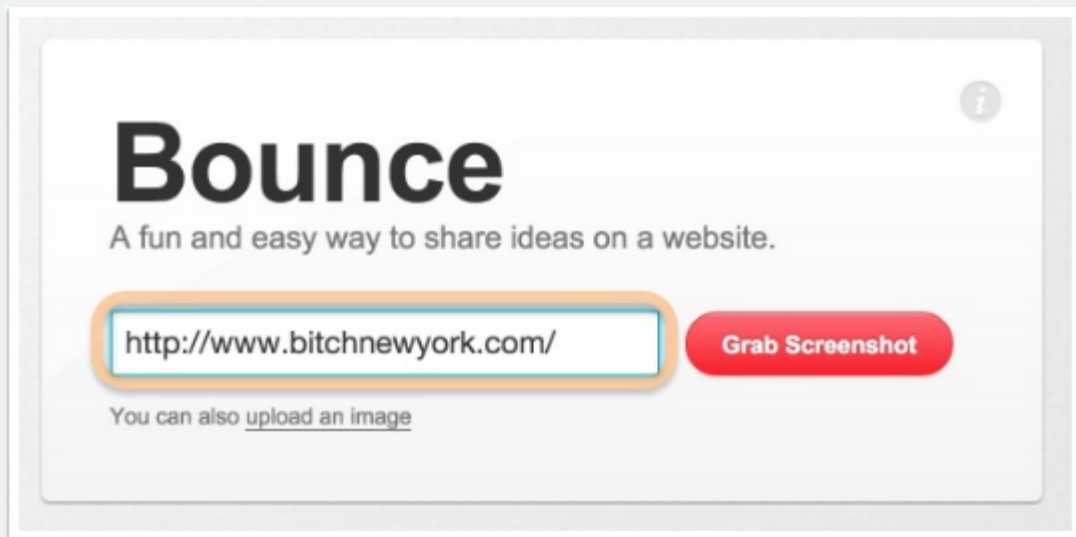

# How to annotate a webpage with BounceApp

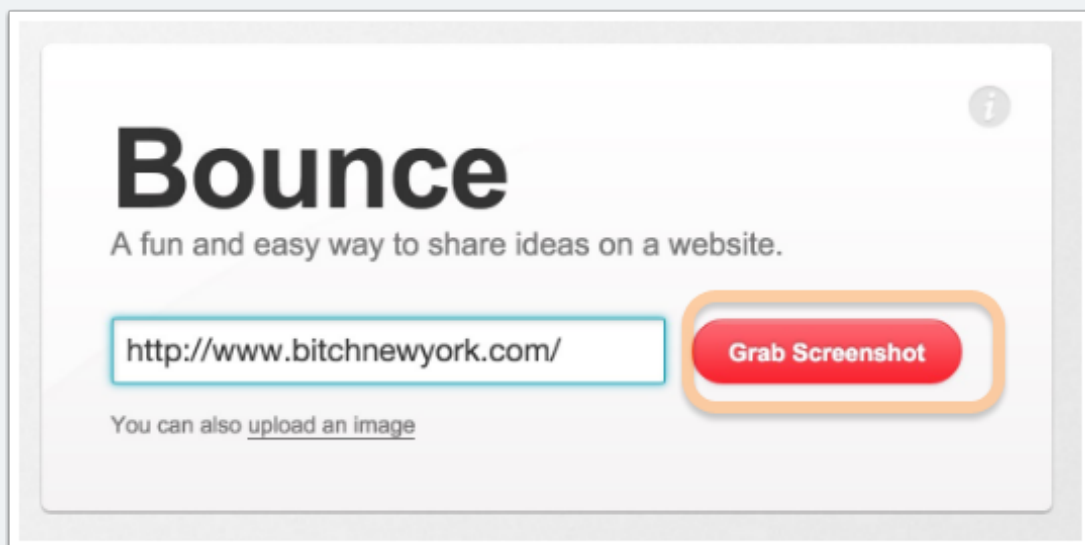
## 2. Identify the webpage you want to annotate

By pasting its web link to the "grab screenshot" entry area. Bitch New York is a high-end, New York city pet boutique.



## 3. BounceApp grabs a screenshot for you

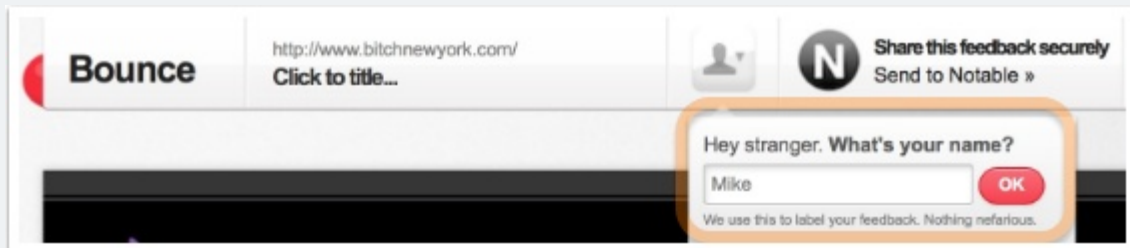
Enjoy the bouncing red ball as you wait for your page to render.



# How to annotate a webpage with BounceApp

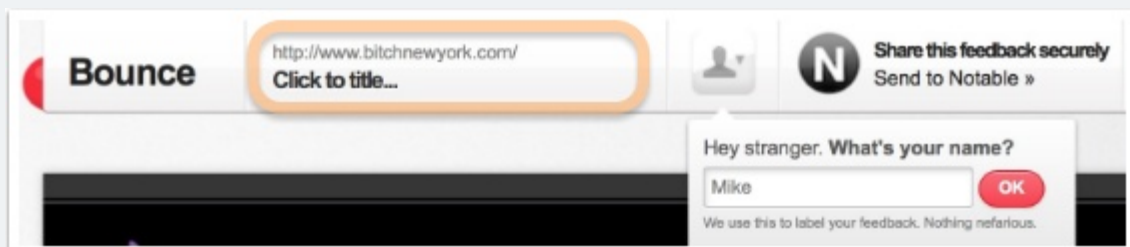
## 4. Once screenshot appears, enter your name

First name will suffice. The service needs to be able to associate a name with your comments, as others will be able to add their own comments and respond to yours.



## 5. Title your annotation as you see fit

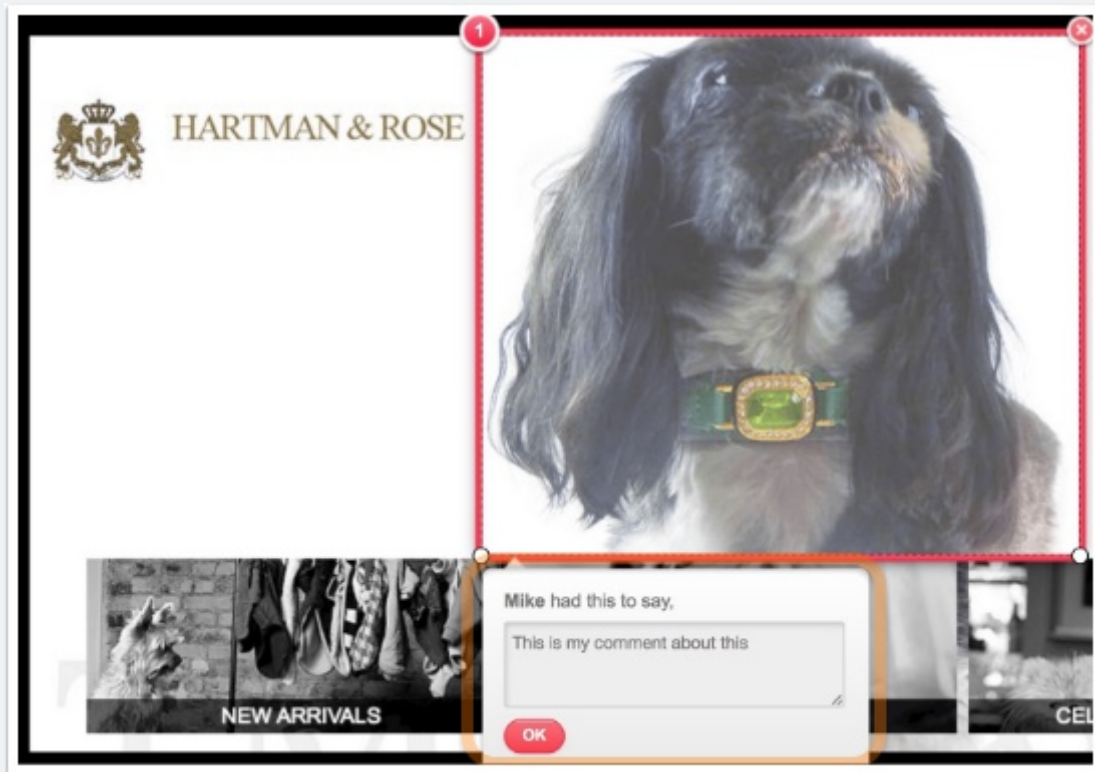
By clicking in the area adjacent to the bounce logo

## 6. Drag and drop to visually highlight an area. Then add your comments...

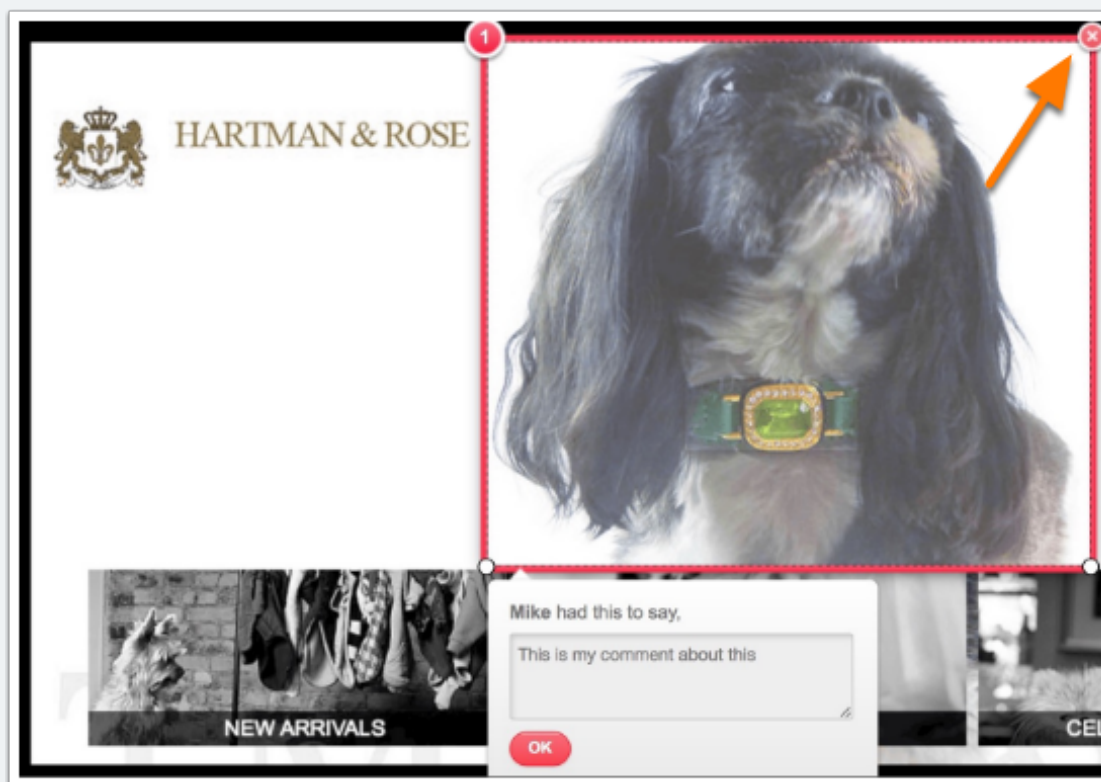
...in the text box area that appears. Hit OK when done.



# How to annotate a webpage with BounceApp

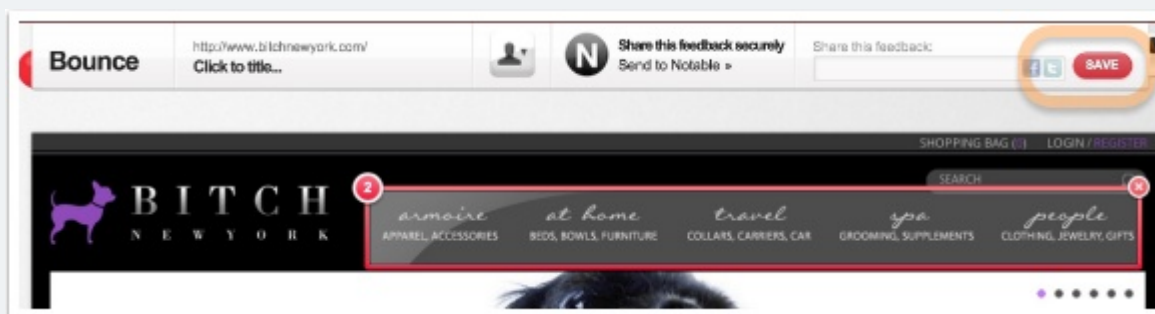
## 7. Repeat process to add additional annotations.

Delete an annotation by clicking on the x in the upper right hand corner of the highlighted visual



## 8. Save your annotations!

Click the red "save" button in the upper right corner of the page.



# How to annotate a webpage with BounceApp

## 9. Copy the link to your annotated page

Return to your link to make further edits. Note that once someone else adds commentary, a new link will be generated, so your original annotated page will be preserved.
