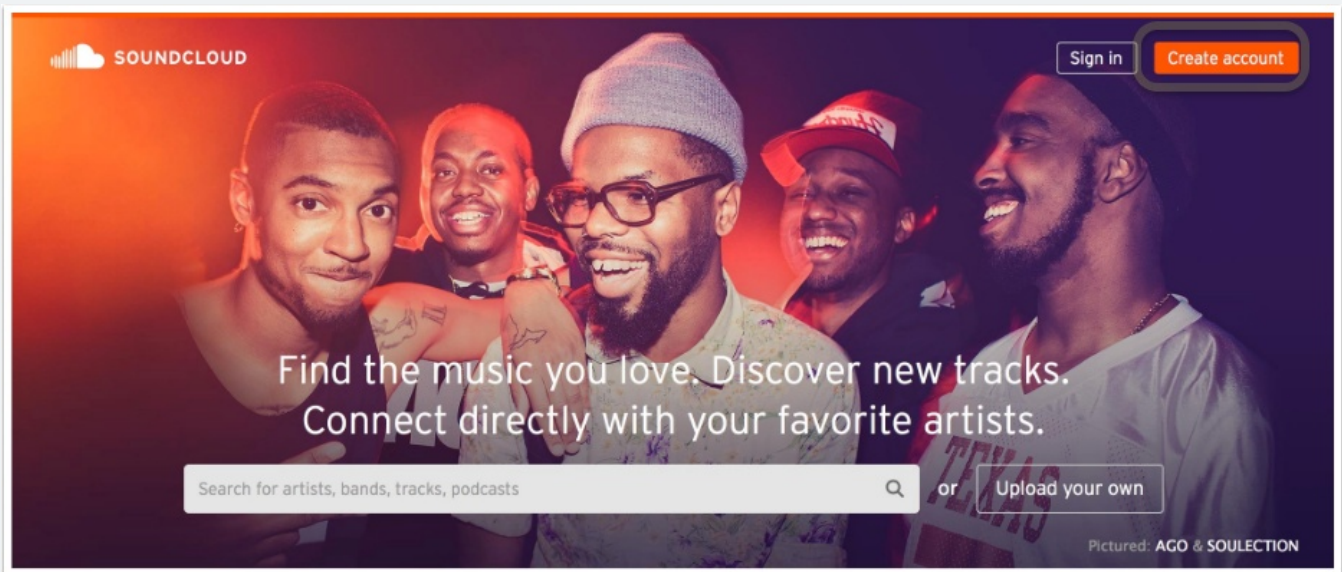


Creating a SoundCloud Recording

How to record and share a file (and create an account) on SoundCloud

1. Create a soundcloud account (if you don't have one)

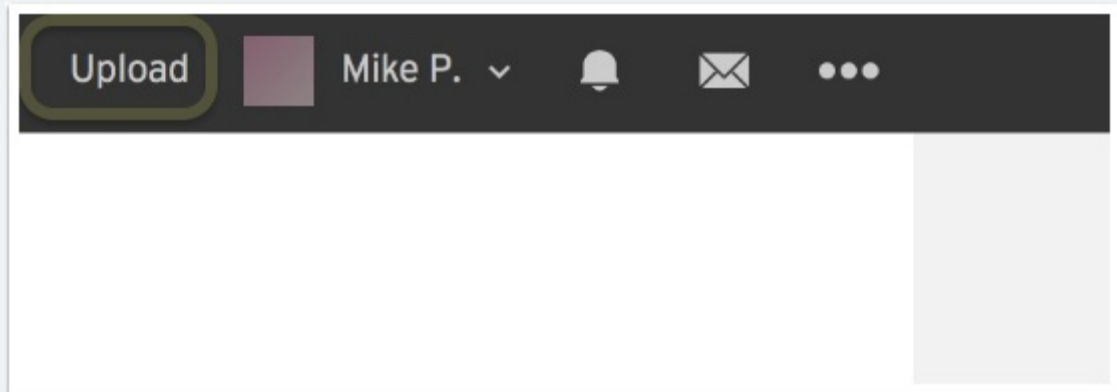
Visit www.soundcloud.com and click "create account"



Creating a SoundCloud Recording

2. Initiate File Recording Process

Once you've created an account, click "upload" on the main menu bar.



3. Start Recording

When ready hit the "record" button.

4. Enable your microphone

Allow the service to access your microphone as needed.



5. Record your script

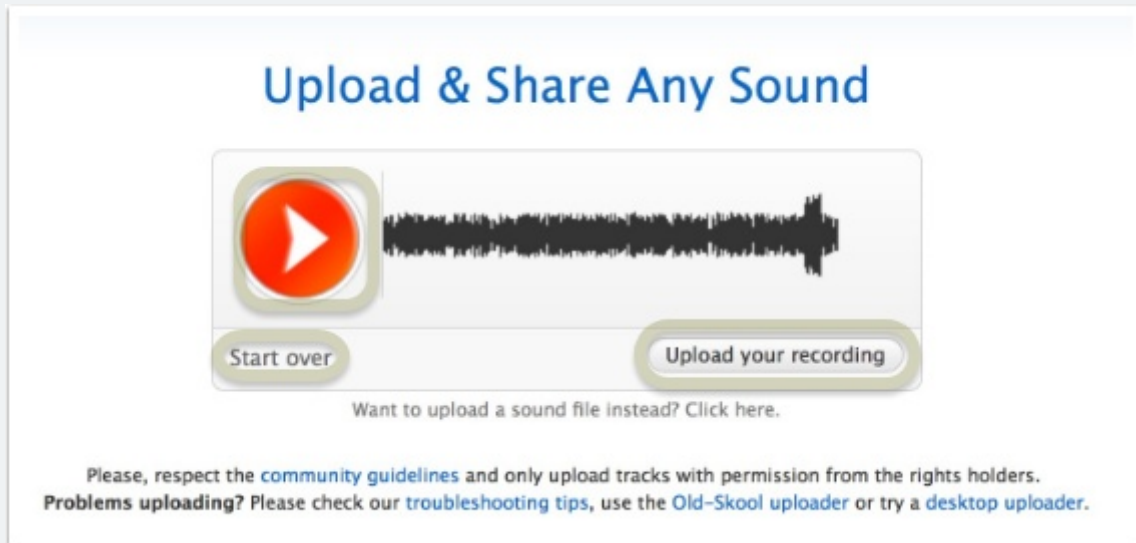
Use your script to tell your foreign market entry story. Don't sweat minor mistakes. When done, hit the red record button again to stop recording.

6. Play back and upload your recording


Do this by pressing the red button which now will bear a play symbol. If satisfied, click "upload your recording." Otherwise click "start over" to re-record. Remember imperfection is fine.

7. Title your recording

After clicking "upload your recording", you will be brought to this page. Edit your title.



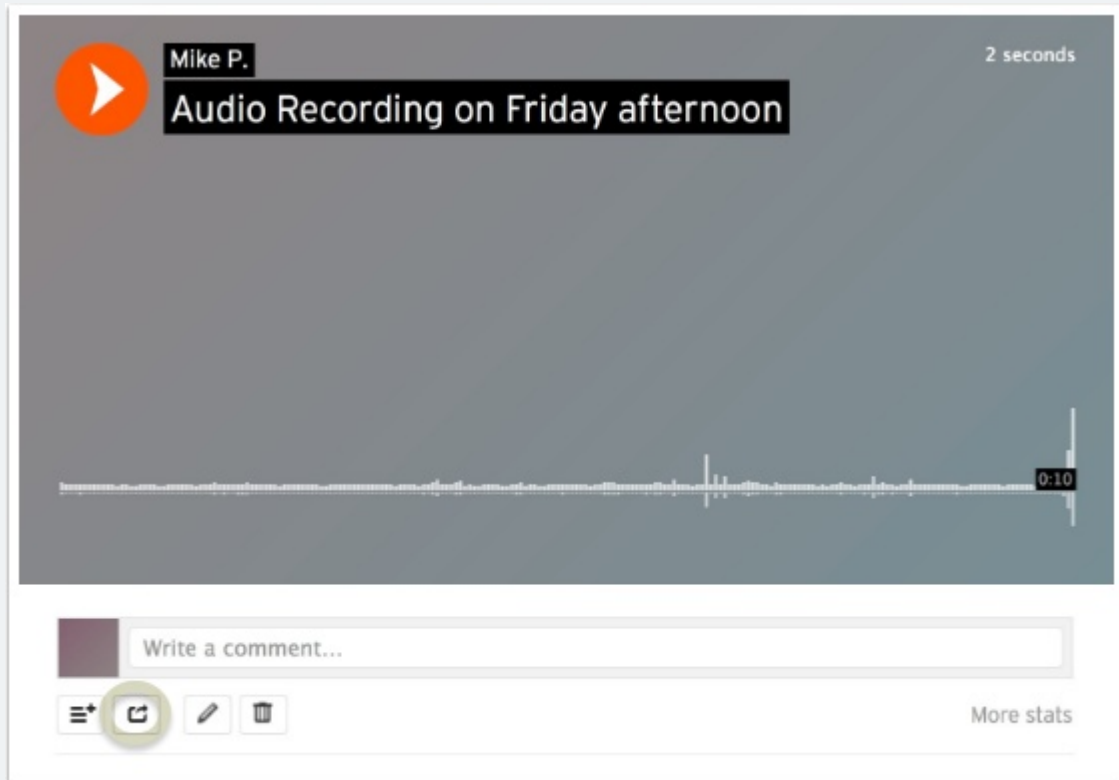
